



Worship Resources for Structural Changes

Watch for these upcoming worship resources to help communities of faith through the remit-related transitions and changes in governance structure:

- November 25 (Christ the King Sunday): a liturgical act, including a prayer to offer thanks as presbyteries and Conferences come to an end. Also available at the above URL: "Sankofa: Looking Back, Moving Forward" and "Simple Service of Goodbye," services for church courts that are closing in this time of transition.
- January 6 (Epiphany Sunday): a liturgical act to help communities of faith celebrate the start of new relationships in their regional councils
- June 9 (Union Sunday): a liturgical act that focuses on being a church with new relationships; includes a communion liturgy
